NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF APPLICANT'S ENVIRONMENTAL STATEMENT AND
REQUEST FOR COMMENTS FROM STATE AND LOCAL AGENCIES

Pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 and the Atomic Energy Commission's regulations in Appendix D to 10 CFR Part 50, notice is hereby given that a document entitled "Environmental Statement - Dresden Nuclear Power Station Unit 3" is being placed in the Commission's Public Document Room, 1717 H Street, N. W., Washington, D. C., and in the office of the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, Grundy County Courthouse, Morris, Illinois. This proceeding involves the application by Commonwealth Edison Company for a license to operate the Dresden Nuclear Power Station Unit 3 which is located on the applicant's site in Grundy County, Illinois. Provisional Construction Permit No. CPPR-22 authorizing construction of the Dresden Nuclear Power Station Unit 3 was issued by the Commission on October 14, 1966.

The Commission hereby requests, within 60 days of publication of this notice in the FEDERAL REGISTER, comments on the proposed action and on the Environmental Statement from State and local agencies of any affected State (with respect to matters within their jurisdiction) which are authorized to develop and enforce environmental standards. If any such State or local agency fails to provide the Commission with comments within 60 days of publication of this notice in the FEDERAL REGISTER, it will be presumed that the agency has no comments to make. Copies of the Environmental

Statement and the comments thereon of Federal agencies whose comments have been requested by the Commission will be supplied to such State and local agencies upon request addressed to the Director, Division of Reactor Licensing, U. S. Atomic Energy Commission, Washington, D. C. 20545.
