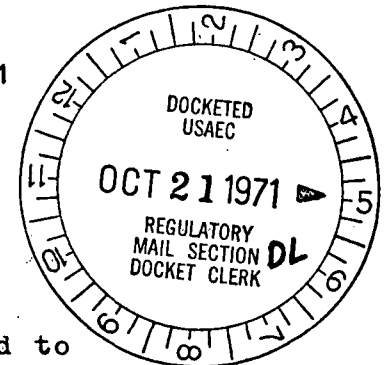

Subject: Request to extend time required to submit supplementary environmental information on Dresden Unit 3

Dear Dr. Morris:

Supplementary environmental information required by Appendix D will be submitted for Dresden Unit 3 by November 8, 1971. However, this submittal will not contain the necessary cost-benefit analysis.

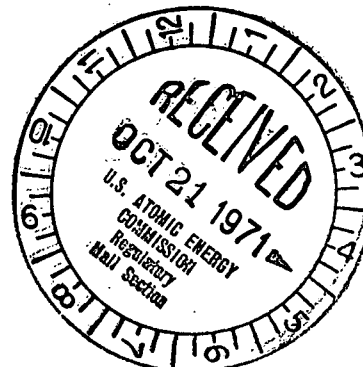
The purpose of this letter is to request an extension of 60 days for the filing of such analysis. The reason for the delay is the difficulty of formulating this new type of analysis and our necessity for doing so for several units. We expect our first cost-benefit analysis, that relating to Quad-Cities Station, to be filed with the Commission about November 1 followed by a submittal for Zion Units 1 and 2 by December 8, 1971. If the extension requested is granted, it will be followed by the analysis relating to Dresden Unit 3.
