Dear Ms. Bergin:

This is in reference to your letter dated June 29, 2017, requesting to amend your NRC License No. 45-31299-01 to add Mojgan Soleimani as Radiation Safety Officer (RSO). In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. Ms. Soleimani's resume indicates a familiarity with Canadian licenses and regulations. Please describe the experience and training Ms. Soleimani has with NRC regulations and license compliance.
2. Confirm the RSO will have full access to all activities involving the use of licensed material and the authority to stop any activity in which health and safety appear to be compromised without consulting with executive management.

In order to continue prompt review of your application, we request that you submit your response to this letter within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter.

Please be aware that you may request that certain portions of your submittal to NRC be withheld from public disclosure as proprietary information. To do this, you must execute an affidavit as specified in 10 CFR 2.390. You must list all portions that you wish to be held proprietary, along with your reasoning as to why that is appropriate. While it is allowable, please refrain from submitting proprietary information in support of a license unless necessary. Keep in mind that all NRC licenses are considered to be in the public domain, and therefore may be viewed by any member of the public who requests to see them.
