This refers to U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) License Number 19-31447-02, Docket No. 03038479, Control No. 594638, to our letter and application dated April 24, 2017, to Email, dated 31 May 2017, from Mr. Dennis Lawyer, NRC, and to a telephone conversation, 19 July, between Mr. Dennis Lawyer, NRC, and Mr. Craig Goldberg and Ms. Claudia Hallam, CECOM Directorate for Safety.

As requested, the following clarification is being provided in response to your question regarding the qualifications of personnel serving as Radiation Safety Committee members:

Army Regulation 385-10, Chapter 2-22, defines that Radiation Safety Council membership shall include the Commander/Director as the Chair (or a designee who is a senior member of the Commander's/Director's staff), the RSO (recorder), and the major subordinate command RSOs. These are also the voting members of CECOM's RSC. All other support personnel (Fire Department, Industrial Hygiene, etc.) are non-voting members invited for informational purposes only.

The minimum qualifications for voting members of CECOM's RSC are as follows: a) any GS-1306 Health Physicist, which is considered by the Army as a qualified Radiation Safety Professional, or b) authorized users or other personnel trained by a GS-1306 Health Physicist in the areas of basic radiation interactions, radioactivity, terms and units, biological effects, radiation detection and measurement, radiation and contamination control, and dosimetry.
