RE: Reply to Letter Dated January 4, 2017

Dear Ms. Henderson:

Enclosed please find our reply to your letter dated January 4, 2017. For your convenience we have enclosed your questions with our reply.

In your letter, you submitted a copy of the training material as required by Item 6 of the Confirmatory Order. We reviewed the material and determined that the material does not adequately demonstrate that the training addresses (1) CampCo compliance responsibilities with NRC requirements for exempt distribution licenses and (2) the specific requirements and obligations associated with the CampCo NRC license. We note that the agenda includes the topic of "Reviewing the NRC Regulations;" however, the training slides and quiz provided do not adequately demonstrate that the training addresses discussion and confirms understanding of the following areas:

- **All applicable NRC regulations for exempt distribution licenses;**
- **The specific requirements and obligations associated with the CampCo license; and**
- **All applicable CampCo procedures.**

Please revise the training material to address the above subjects, and resubmit the training material for NRC review in accordance with Items 6d and 6e in Section IV of the Confirmatory Order. In recognition of the efforts needed for revising your training and the delay of the NRC review, I am granting an extension to the timeframe specified in the order for you to respond with your revisions. You are now required to provide NRC with your revised training plan within 45 days of the date of this letter.

The training we received was provided by Mr. Sean Chapel of IRSC, Inc. Mr. Chapel went over the terms and conditions of both our NRC and state of CA licenses, reviewed and discussed our procedures, went over the NRC information notice on exempt distribution reports, and had pulled up various NRC regulations on the internet for discussion. All of these topics (with the


exception of the procedures) are listed on the course syllabus, which is enclosed for your reference. It was a comprehensive discussion.

We propose as a way to provide evidence that this training requirement has been satisfied, that IRSC place the required content in their online training system, and Campco individuals take the training and pass the quiz, after which they will receive a certificate of attendance. The content will cover the all applicable NRC regulations for exempt distribution licenses; the specific requirements and obligations associated with the CampCo license; and all applicable CampCo procedures.

Please let us know if this is an acceptable arrangement. If so IRSC will make the slides available online for the NRC for review.
