On June 12, 2015, the NRC issued a final rulemaking to amend 10 CFR 71 regulations. Among the changes made was an update to the administrative procedures for the quality assurance program requirements described in 10 CFR 71, Subpart H. Specifically, 10 CFR 71.38 has been amended to remove the requirements for the renewal of Quality Assurance Program Approvals, and 10 CFR 71.106 was added to establish requirements that will apply to changes to quality assurance programs.

Quality Assurance Program Approval for Radioactive Material Packages number 0341, Revision 9 was issued to Entergy Operations, Arkansas Nuclear One (ANO), Units 1 and 2, August 17, 2015. 10 CFR 71.106 requires changes that are made to the ANO quality assurance program that do not reduce commitments must be submitted to the NRC every 24-months, with the reporting period starting on the date the latest approval was given. This submittal is required even if no changes were made to the program in the previous 24-months.

The purpose of this submittal is to provide the required notification to the NRC of changes made to the quality assurance program for radioactive material packages during the reporting period of August 2015 to July 2017.

There have been no changes made to the program during the reporting period.

This letter contains no new commitments.
