SUBJECT: MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS/SEARCH REQUIREMENTS
ST. LUCIE PLANT (TAC 65268/65269)

This is to acknowledge receipt of the Florida Power and Light Company letter, dated December 2, 1986, which transmitted a proposed amendment to the St. Lucie Plant Physical Security Plan, in response to the Miscellaneous Amendments and Search Requirements.

The submitted document has been reviewed and we have determined that additional information and revisions to the plan are required prior to our approval. The enclosed comments are based upon pertinent NRC regulations and published guidance describing methods, acceptable to the NRC staff, for implementing specific parts of those regulations.

It is requested that you provide your response to these comments within 30 days from receipt of this letter.

The reporting and/or record keeping requirements contained in this letter affect fewer than ten respondents; therefore, OMB clearance is not required under P.L. 96-511.

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COMMENTS ON PHYSICAL SECURITY PLAN CHANGES
(MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS AND SEARCH REQUIREMENTS)
ST. LUCIE PLANT

State that vital area access controls will not be dropped for life threatening situations not involving public health and safety. Reference 10 CFR 50.54(x) and (y) and Generic Letter 87-08 (Q&A #3).

Provide a commitment that a physical pat-down search of an individual shall be conducted if there is cause to suspect that an individual is attempting to bring firearms, explosives, or incendiary devices into the protected area. Reference 10 CFR 73.55(d)(1).

Provide a commitment that vital area access lists shall be updated and reapproved by the cognizant manager/supervisor at least every 31 days (not monthly). Reference 10 CFR 73.55(d)(7)(i)(A). Definition section of plan does not apply to this commitment.

Provide a commitment to ensure prompt access to vital equipment to accommodate the potential need for rapid ingress or egress of individuals during emergency conditions or situations. Indicate how this prompt access will be ensured (e.g., by issuing override keys to appropriate operators and security force members at the start of each shift, or by other acceptable means). Reference 10 CFR 73.55(d)(7)(ii) and Generic Letter 87-08 (Q&A #6).

Provide a commitment that all keys, locks, combinations, and related access control devices used to control access to protected and vital areas shall be changed or rotated at least every 12 months (not annually) or whenever there is evidence or suspicion that any of these devices may have been compromised. Reference 10 CFR 73.55(d)(9). Definition section of plan does not apply to this commitment.

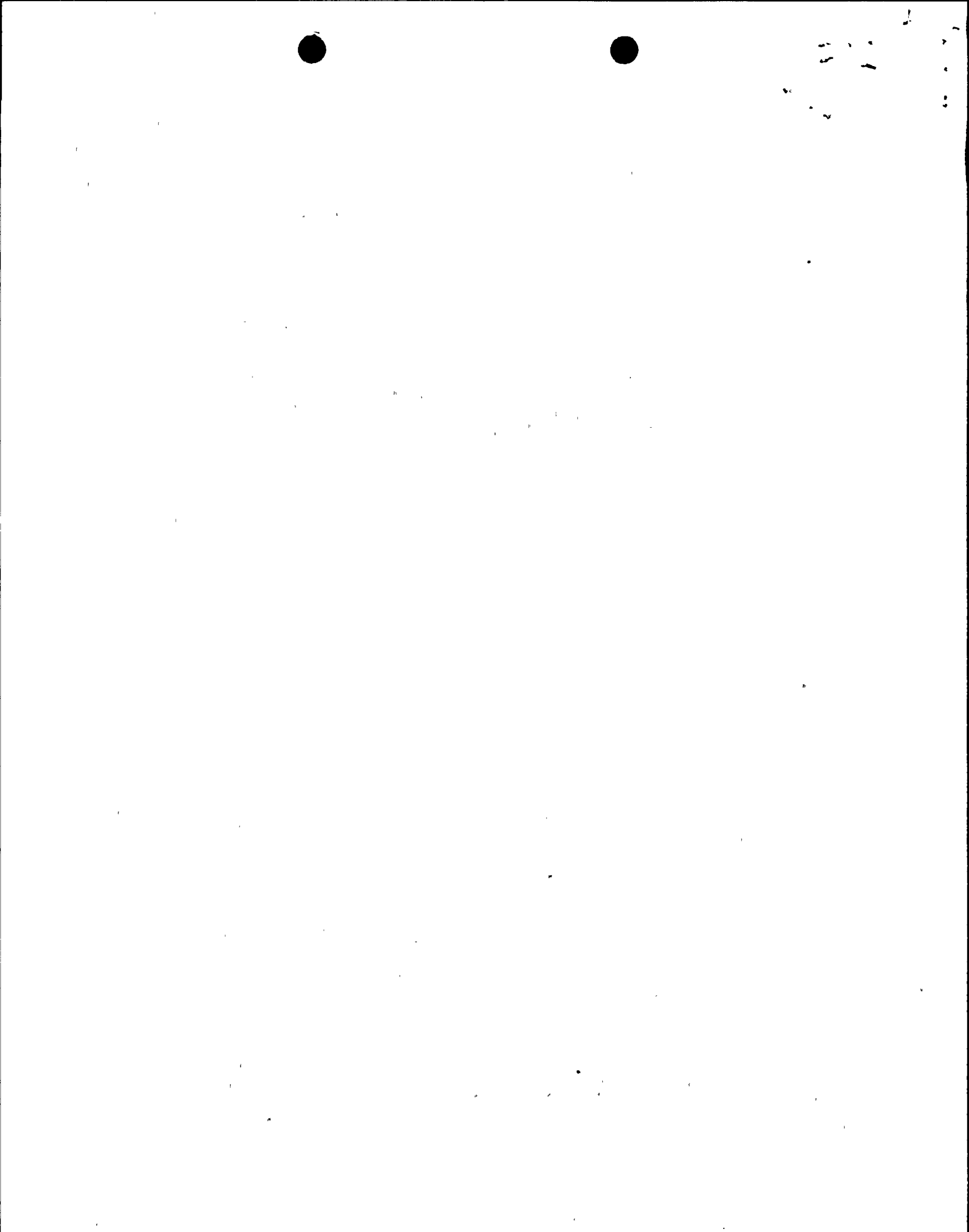
Provide a commitment that whenever an individual's unescorted access is revoked due to lack of trustworthiness, reliability, or inadequate work performance, keys, locks, combinations, and related access control devices to which that person had access shall be changed or rotated. Reference 10 CFR 73.55(d)(9).

Define what actual timing is intended for the "periodic reviews" conducted. Reference 10 CFR 73.55(d)(7)(ii)(B).

Indicate what components of the secondary power supply system will be protected as vital. Reference 10 CFR 73.55(e)(1) and Generic Letter 87-08 (Q&A #18).

Provide a commitment to maintain a log indicating name, badge number, time of entry, and time of exit of all individuals granted access to all vital areas (drop references to unoccupied vital areas) except those individuals entering or exiting the reactor control room. Reference 10 CFR 73.70(d).

Reinclude the reference to Section 5.2.1(e), page 5-6 in your plan; it appears to have been dropped from your previously approved plan.
