1.10. The regulations are intended to be read in conjunction with the organization's employee agreement.

2. EMPLOYMENT

2.1. The organization reserves the right to hire, employ, promote, demote, transfer, suspend, terminate, or otherwise manage its workforce in accordance with these regulations.

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
