In accordance with 10 CFR 50.90, Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) submits herewith a request to amend Facility Operating License NPF-16.

The proposed amendment revises Technical Specification Section 3/4.6.1., Containment Systems, by defining peak accident pressure (Pa) as that experienced during a loss of coolant accident. This proposed amendment will have the required containment test pressure be based on the calculated loss of coolant accident pressure.

A marked up copy of the affected Technical Specification pages are included as Attachment 1. A Safety Analysis in support of the proposed amendment is included as Attachment 2. A "Determination of No Significant Hazards Consideration" is provided as Attachment 3.

The proposed amendment has been reviewed by the St. Lucie Facility Review Group and the Florida Power and Light Company Nuclear Review Board.




