SUBJECT: NUREG-0737 ITEM II.D.1, PERFORMANCE TESTING OF RELIEF AND SAFETY
VALVES - ST. LUCIE PLANT, UNIT NOS. 1 AND 2
(TAC NOS. 44617 AND 51605)

The enclosed staff's Safety Evaluation (Enclosure 1) and the Technical Evaluation Reports (TERs) prepared by EG&G, the staff's contractor (Enclosures 2 and 3), provide the results of the NRC review of the FP&L submittals in response to TMI Action Plan Requirements, NUREG-0737, Item II.D.1, Performance Testing of Relief and Safety Valves. Our review indicates that FP&L has met all of the Item II.D.1 requirements with the exception of the items outlined in Sections 5.2 of the TERs.

FP&L should resolve the remaining discrepancies and document the resolution. It is necessary, however, to submit the documentation. Upon completion, FP&L should not notify the NRC Project Manager. The documentation of the resolution should be available at the St. Lucie Plant site for NRC audit. Within 45 days from the date of this letter, please provide to the NRC Project Manager your schedule for the resolution of the remaining issues. If that schedule is acceptable, we will close TAC Nos. 44617 and 51605 at that time.

The reporting and/or recordkeeping requirements contained in this letter affect fewer than 10 respondents; therefore, OMB clearance is not required pursuant to P.L. 96-511.
