SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF MEETING HELD WITH FLORIDA POWER AND LIGHT (FP&L) TO DISCUSS FINDINGS DURING LICENSED OPERATOR REQUALIFICATION EXAMINATIONS




# **ROOT CAUSE ANALYSIS**


CHANGED EVALUATION TECHNIQUE


