Generic Letter 89-13 (GL 89-13), dated July 18, 1989, requested licensees confirm the establishment of a program to implement NRC staff recommendations for improving the reliability of service water systems.

Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) responded to the staff's request (L-90-28, dated January 25, 1990), stating that two of the staff's five recommendations were fully implemented on both St. Lucie units. Completion schedules for the remaining three recommendations were provided. By letter dated February 27, 1990, the staff acknowledged FPL's response, and requested that it be notified when all recommendations were fully implemented.

Implementation of all recommendations made in GL 89-13 is now complete for St. Lucie Unit 2. As stated in L-90-28, implementation on St. Lucie Unit 1 is scheduled for completion during the Fall, 1991 refueling outage.
