Good morning,

Thank you for returning my call yesterday regarding the new license application dated August 2, 2017 you submitted to the NRC for an elemental analyzer. In order to process your application, you will need to provide the following information to the NRC:

1. It's not clear who is applying for the license – Item 2 of the application you provided lists OmniSource LLC as the applicant with their mailing address identified in Fort Wayne, IN; Item 3 of the application states that the material will be used at a different company - SDI Lafarga, LLC located in New Haven, IN. The application states that both of these business entities are subsidiaries of Steel Dynamics. We cannot proceed until one company has been identified as the licensee, not two different subsidiaries.
2. Submit an application (NRC Form 313) signed by a representative of management for the company responsible for licensed activities. The application was signed by you, Quality Manager/proposed RSO, representing OmniSource, LLC; however, it's not clear what company is applying for the license (OmniSource, LLC or SDI Lafarga, LLC). The application must be signed by a management representative, "management" refers to the processes for conduct and control of a radiation safety program and to the individuals who are responsible for those processes and who have authority to provide necessary resources to achieve regulatory compliance;
3. Submit a delegation of authority for the Radiation Safety Officer – refer to Appendix C of NUREG-1556, Volume 4, Rev 1 "Program Specific Guidance About Fixed Gauges"
