The Georgia Environmental Protection Division, Radioactive Materials Program has review the Environmental Assessment (EA) and Safety Evaluation Report (SER) for Building 181, Robbins Air Force Base. We do not have any comments related to these two items. We would request that once demolition is completed and soil contamination surveys are accomplished, that should these survey's reveal any soil contamination, a ground water survey be conducted. In the past we have seen some instance of ground water contamination around a contaminated vault that had to be remediated. While we do not believe this to be the case in this instance, if the survey's should show soil contamination, then we feel that a ground water survey is prudent.
