SUBJECT: ST. LUCIE PLANT, UNITS 1 AND 2 - RESPONSE TO 10 CFR 50.63,
STATION BLACKOUT (TAC NOS. M68608 AND M68609)

The NRC staff's Safety Evaluation (SE) pertaining to your initial responses to the Station Blackout (SBO) Rule, 10 CFR 50.63, was sent to you by letter dated September 12, 1991. The staff found your proposed method of coping with an SBO to be acceptable, subject to the satisfactory resolution of several recommendations which were itemized in the staff's SE. You responded to the staff's SE, and specifically to the recommendations, by letter dated November 26, 1991.

The staff has reviewed your responses and finds them acceptable. The details of that review are contained in the enclosed Supplemental SE.

This completes our review of this issue and, consequently, we are closing TAC Nos. M68608 and M68609.
