Dear Mr. McConnell:

Enclosed is your NRC Material License No. 12-32079-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that due to the information you provided regarding the move of location for administrative license control from Indianapolis, Indiana to Springfield, Illinois your previous license No. 13-32079-01 has been terminated and a new license generated in accordance with NRC policy.

In your correspondence to us dated May 23, 2017, you indicated that you wished to release for unrestricted use a former licensed facility located at 7172 Graham Road, Suite 125, Indianapolis, Indiana. Based on the information provided, the staff has concluded that all licensable material has been removed from this facility, and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria. Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required for this address of use and this location is suitable for unrestricted use.

Please note that the format of your license has changed due to our new licensing process system. Additionally, a number of conditions on your license have been updated as well. Specifically, Condition 10 has been updated to include information regarding gauge use that may occur in a state participating in the Agreement State program. Condition 11 has been updated to include the requirement that records be maintained for three years for individuals designated as users of the gauge. Condition 13 A. has been updated to include the requirement that in the absence of a registration certificate the interval for leak testing of the gauge is not to exceed six months. Condition 15 has been updated to include the requirement that records of physical inventories must be maintained for three years after they are conducted. Condition 17 has been updated to remove the statement regarding using two physical barriers to secure the gauge as this requirement is fully specified in 10 CFR 30.34(i). Lastly, Condition 19, on your previous license No. 13-32079-01, regarding transportation requirements has been deleted as these requirements are already specified in the regulations in 10 CFR Part 71.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order

suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.

The NRC's Safety Culture Policy Statement became effective in June 2011. While a policy statement and not a regulation, it sets forth the agency's *expectations* for individuals and organizations to establish and maintain a positive safety culture.
