Subject: Combustion Engineering Owners Group Endorsement of Lead Plant Submittal - Florida Power & Light Company Submittal of Indefinite Bypass for Equipment Protective Trips.

Reference: (A) D. A. Sager (FP&L) letter to Nuclear Regulatory Commission Document Control Desk, "High Rate of Change of Power Trip".

The Combustion Engineering Owners Group (CEOG) has reviewed the FP&L proposed technical specification change of Reference (A). We find that this change is applicable to at least three CEOG plants and endorse the proposed change as a lead plant submittal for the CEOG.

This is the first endorsement of a submittal utilizing the lead plant process by the CEOG. As such, we are ready to work with the NRC Staff to refine this process for our mutual benefit. The C-E Owners Group requests that you review and approve the lead plant submittal as expeditiously as possible so that our utilities may take advantage of the Technical specification change. Timely approval will preclude the need for review on individual dockets and will allow utilities to more effectively plan for implementation of similar changes.

In accordance with my letter of November 12, 1992, to Mr. J. G. Partlow, submittals made by the CEOG to the NRC are not applicable to any individual licensee until the submittal is referenced by that licensee for use on its docket. Should the NRC have questions within the scope of any CEOG submittal, they should be addressed to the Owners group Chairman. Questions which regard a specific lead plant submittal should be addressed to the licensee.

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
