Dear Mr. Gallagher,

We hereby confirm receipt of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's request for

additional information as described in your email below. Before we address your inquiry, please note that José Escobar, Esq. (copied in this email) will represent the Purchaser, Hospital Menonita Guayama Inc. in all matters related to the change of control (ownership) of the Materials License No. 52-30883-01 (“the NRC License”) before the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. In regard to item number 1 of your inquiry, as per certain Asset Purchase Agreement (“the APA”) executed on July 6, 2017 by and between Hospital Episcopal San Lucas Guayama, Inc. (“HESLG”), Iglesia Episcopal Puertorriqueña, Inc. (“IEP”) and Menonita Guayama Inc. (“Menonita”), title and ownership of Hospital Episcopal San Lucas Guayama, located in the municipality of Guayama, Puerto Rico, (“the Hospital”) will be transferred to Menonita, as well as all assets related to its operation and subject to the NRC License and the applicable statutory and regulatory requirements related thereto. In other words, upon closing of the transaction, Menonita will own and operate the Hospital facilities, equipment and materials that are subject to the NRC License program. To be clear, Menonita is not acquiring any stock nor will it merge with HESLG. Menonita will have its own and independent Board of Directors once the transaction is closed. As indicated in our July 28, 2017 letter, this transaction is expect to close on August 31, 2017.

With respect to item number 2, upon closing of the transaction, Menonita will continue to operate the Hospital and perform all activities subject to the NRC License without any changes to the licensed program’s current organizational structure. For the purposes of the NRC License, Menonita will continue to operate the facility with its current Radiation Safety Officer, Mr. Carmelo Pérez, and without any changes in personnel.
