The proposed amendment will make changes to Technical Specification 4.6.1.2.a, Containment Leakage Surveillance Requirements, consistent with the guidance of NUREG-1432, "Standard Technical Specifications for Combustion Engineering Plants." FPL considers this proposed amendment to be an administrative change to the manner in which the retest schedule for Type A Tests, which determine the Overall Integrated Containment Leakage Rate, is stated.

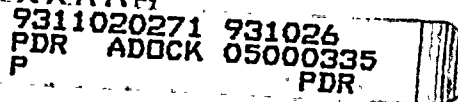
