SUBJECT: ST. LUCIE PLANT, UNITS 1 AND 2 - RESPONSE TO GENERIC LETTER 89-19,  
STEAM GENERATOR OVERFILL PROTECTION (TAC NOS. M75002 AND M75003)

By letter dated March 19, 1990, you responded to Generic Letter 89-19 for the St. Lucie Plant, Units 1 and 2. The staff has reviewed your response and concluded that St. Lucie Units 1 and 2 have acceptable automatic steam generator overfill protection and that the plant operating procedures and operator training program are adequate to ensure that the operators can handle the full spectrum of possible small break loss-of-coolant accident scenarios. Enclosed is our Safety Evaluation.

This concludes our review of this issue and, consequently, we are closing TAC Nos. M75002 and M75003.
