FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY - ST. LUCIE UNIT 1

Dear Mr. Allen:

The NRC has recently been made aware of a complaint filed in Federal court in Miami by the Florida Power & Light Company concerning steam generators supplied by Combustion Engineering, Inc. for use in St. Lucie Unit 1. The NRC became aware of this complaint from a telephone call placed by a newspaper reporter who called one of our Project Managers. The resulting article appeared in a local business newspaper which included remarks made by this Project Manager.

At this time, the NRC has no position and thus no comment on the merits of the complaint. The remarks, although somewhat misquoted, were those of the Project Manager and not those of NRC.

We wish to remind you of your responsibilities under 10 CFR Part 21 for the review, evaluation, and reporting to NRC of defects in safety-related equipment, materials, and services which may be identified by you at any time, including during the review and discovery process resulting from the complaint.

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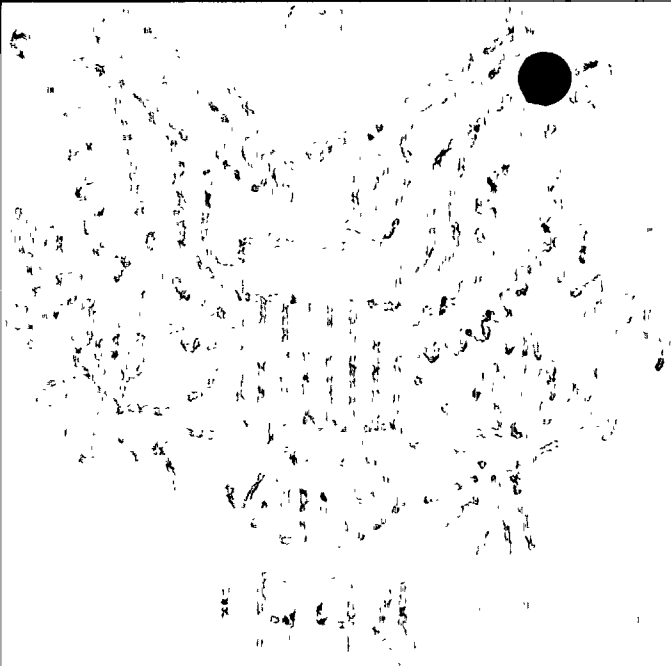
