I am working on the letters RRMC submitted to add 3 and remove 2 authorized users from your license (No. 44-14121-01). I need the additional information requested below to continue our review. Please let me know if you have any questions or need additional information. I also left you a voicemail to call me back.

1. You are requesting the removal of Dr. James Rademacher. Please confirm that you wish to retain him as radiation safety officer (RSO). If you wish to remove him as RSO, please submit the information required by 10 CFR 35.50 and/or 35.57.
2. Please submit a copy of the board certification for Drs. Coleman and Shelton. These were omitted during the original submission.
3. Please submit documentation of the supervised clinical casework to support Dr. Shelton's request for I-131 use under 10 CFR 35.300, signed by a qualified preceptor.
4. Please submit documentation of the required 200 hours of classroom and laboratory training for Dr. Hummel's request for I-131 use under 10 CFR 35.300, signed by a qualified preceptor.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. If we do not receive a response from you within 30 days, we will assume you no longer wish to pursue these actions.
