Dear Mr. Jackson:

It has come to our attention that Amendment No. 83 to your NRC Material License No. 21-04109-16 dated January 9, 2017, contained several errors.

Enclosed is a corrected copy to Amendment No. 83 reflecting the more significant corrections as follows:

1. The language and date of initiating correspondence was missing from Subitem No. 3 on page 1;
2. The order of authorized radionuclides in Subitem Nos. 6 – 9 J, K, L and M was restored to the order as it appeared on Amendment No. 82;
3. In Condition 10.D., the wording "Subitem Nos. 6.8..." was changed to "Subitem Nos. 6.B...;" and,
4. Condition No. 17 was completed with the addition of language concerning the maintenance of records for physical inventories.

Several other minor formatting errors were also corrected at this time.

We apologize for these errors and for any inconvenience they may have caused.

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
