Mr. Foley,

This is in reference to your response to a request for additional information, dated August 2, 2017. Your response was not satisfactory for item 1 and 3 of our request for information letter dated July 27, 2017. Please read the question closely and ensure a complete response. Additionally, we need more information concerning item 2. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. Our previous question: The revised application includes the following statements in Item 7: "Before using licensed materials, authorized users receive the training described in Appendix G in NUREG-1556, **Volume 7.**" Please note that Appendix G is in regards to Guidance on Decommissioning Funding Plan and Financial Assurance, and Appendix J is in regards to Radiation Safety Training Topics. Please revise the application statement on training.

In item one, you have the statement under the "Authorized Users" section of your application, "Before using licensed material, authorized users receive the training described in Appendix G in NUREG-1556." Please note it does not appear you included a volume number which makes the statement ambiguous. Please provide the statement including the volume number of the NUREG-1556.

2. You provided the experience level of the proposed authorized users. One proposed authorized user, Bo Ding, does not appear to have experience in the use and handling of Iodine 125 or a similar radionuclide. Please provide additional information describing why Bo Ding is qualified to become an authorized user of Iodine 125 or withdraw the request for him to be an authorized user for this material.
3. Our previous question was: The revised application item 9 made a statement of facility but was unclear to locations of certain materials. Will all radioactive material use be isolated to this room or do you wish to include other locations within the building for radioactive use. If so, please diagram the other location with room numbers, building location and name. If all material will be located to the same room, please clearly make this statement.

In this item, it appears you responded by including the room number and diagram of the area that will be used for radioactive waste. There is one counter in another lab that is boxed in the diagrams. You made statements that two to three labs will be used. Please submit clearly which areas are designated for radioactive material use. Please provide the room numbers and diagram of the lab use areas. Please provide a diagram of the lab use area, stating that it is a lab use area. Please be clear the area that will be used for radioactive materials using words as well as diagrams.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to the attention of Dennis Lawyer, at the Region 1 Office (Address below) and refer to Mail Control No. 594682. If you have technical questions, we can be reached at (610) 337-5366.

Your reply must be an originally signed and dated letter. The letter may be scanned and submitted as a pdf document attached to an email; or it may be transmitted by facsimile to (610) 337-5269; or it may be sent by regular mail. If we do not receive a reply from you within 7 calendar days from the date of this e-mail, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your application.
