Mr. Vasquez and Mr. Vonehr,

The Qal-Tek RSC has approved the updated shipping procedure (OP-PRO-152) that includes package selection, packaging instructions and closure instructions. Each QTA shipper will be individually OJT'd by the RSO (author of procedure changes forwarded to you earlier) prior to shipping sources individually. Upon successful completion of shipping procedure OJT each shipper will sign a training log and the RSO will complete the OJT form and present to the RSC as evidence they understand and properly executed the procedure individually and have met the function specific trained requirements on packaging selection, packaging instructions and packaging closure to prevent reoccurrence.

This ban is effectively lifted by QTA as each shipper completes the function specific training above. The first QTA shipper to complete this training was on June 6th, 2017.
