Enclosed is an application (XSNM3783), dated August 1, 2017, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, from the U.S. Department of Energy, National Nuclear Security Administration, Y-12 National Security Complex. The application requests the export of low-enriched uranium first to France for fuel fabrication, then to the Republic of Korea for uranium molybdenum powder fabrication, and ultimately to Japan for use as fuel at the Kyoto University Research Reactor Institute.

Assurances from EURATOM, Japan, and the Republic of Korea that the material will be subject to all of the terms and conditions of respective agreements for cooperation, are required. Your assistance in obtaining the necessary assurances will be appreciated.
