A patient was prescribed a biliary dose to the gall bladder (containing 5-6 mCi Tc-99m and Medrofenin), but received a bone dose of 25 mCi Tc-99m with Medronate or MDT.

The patient was notified of the error. No adverse harm to the patient is expected.

Connected the RSO with the R3DO (McCraw). The R3DO said the event is likely not reportable since the dose is relatively small (less than 150 mCi), but the RSO will contact their health physics consultant to determine the doses to the patient to be sure.
