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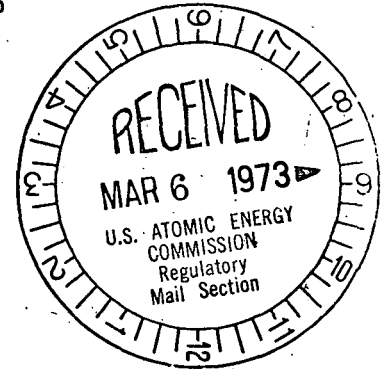

Dear Mr. O'Leary:

Attached is the operating quality assurance program for Dresden Units 2 and 3, submitted as Proposed Modification 73-1. This is submitted in response to Mr. D. J. Skovholt's letter of December 4, 1972 to Mr. Byron Lee and is called Exhibit 1.1 of Appendix E.

The revised operating quality assurance program is based on the quality assurance program for operation presented in response to Question 1.5 of the Zion Final Safety Analysis Report, AEC Dkts 50-295 and 50-304. The Zion program complies with Safety Guide 33 and therefore the Dresden Units 2 and 3 operating quality assurance program will comply with Safety Guide 33.

The nuclear fuel quality assurance program for Commonwealth Edison is presently being reviewed by the company. It is anticipated that this program will be submitted as a modification to the Safety Analysis Report about April 1, 1973.

The Dresden Station Review Board and the Commonwealth Edison Nuclear Review Board have reviewed and approved Proposed Modification 73-1.


