Re: Amendment Nos. 11 and 12 to the applications for construction permits and operating licenses for Dresden Units 2 and 3 filed under AEC Dkts 50-237 and 50-249, respectively

Dear Dr. Morris:

The applications for construction permits and operating licenses for Dresden Unit 2, filed April 15, 1965, in AEC Dkt 50-237, and for Dresden Unit 3, filed February 10, 1966, in AEC Dkt 50-249, are hereby amended by submission of Amendment 11 for Dresden Unit 2 and Amendment 12 for Dresden Unit 3 pursuant to Sec. 50.34 of 10CFR50.

Said amendments consist of the following:

- A - Answers to Questions I-A and I-B forwarded by letter from Dr. Morris dated January 14, 1969;
- B - Page changes to Volumes I and II of the FSAR which incorporate information in the following areas:
 - 1 - Electrical independence within the on-site emergency power system. This material is Commonwealth's response to a letter from Dr. Morris dated October 29, 1968; and
 - 2 - Corrections to the page changes of Amendments 7/8 forwarded by Commonwealth's letter dated August 30, 1968;
- C - Supplementary information on the answers to questions forwarded by letter from Dr. Morris dated June 27, 1968. This supplementary information was requested in a meeting between Commonwealth and the AEC Staff on November 18, 1968. Amendments 7/8 forwarded by Commonwealth's letter of August 30, 1968 contained the original answers to the Dr. Morris letter of June 27, 1968;

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- D - Page changes which were referenced on the Errata and Addenda sheet for Amendments 7/8 but were not included;
- E - Volume V (forwarded under separate cover); and
- F - Divider sheets for appendices in Volume IV.

The Errata and Addenda sheet for the information described in Paragraph D above should be corrected to indicate in the 1st and 3rd line of the instructions that Page viii is to be removed and inserted rather than vii.


Volume V should be used to bind the answers to questions forwarded by the AEC. Volume IV should contain only the appendices and their identifying divider sheets.

In addition to three signed originals 77 copies of these amendments are also submitted.


