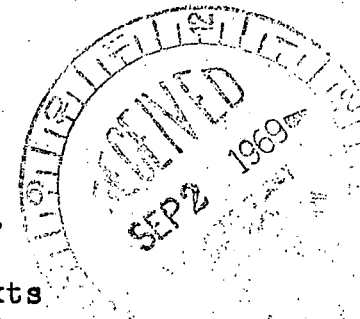

Subject: Amendments 19 and 20 to the applications for construction permits and operating licenses for Dresden Units 2 and 3 filed under AEC Dkts 50-237 and 50-249, respectively

The applications for construction permits and operating licenses for Dresden Unit 2, filed April 14, 1965 in AEC Dkt 50-237, and for Dresden Unit 3, filed February 10, 1966 in AEC Dkt 50-249, are hereby amended by submission of Amendment 19 for Dresden Unit 2 and Amendment 20 for Dresden Unit 3.

These amendments consist of the following:

- A. Additional information on the significance of failure of the Rod Block Monitor System which should be inserted in Volume VI; and
- B. Revised proposed technical specifications which should be inserted in Volume III after all existing pages in Volume III are removed and destroyed; and
- C. Additional information on the seismic design of the plant which should be inserted in Volume VI.
