
These amendments consist of additional information in the following areas and should be inserted in Volume VI:

- C - Capability of certain plant features in relation to TID 14844 accident source term.


In addition to three signed originals, 77 copies of these amendments are also submitted.

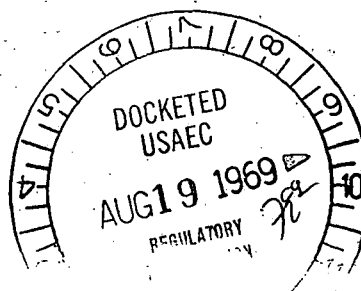
