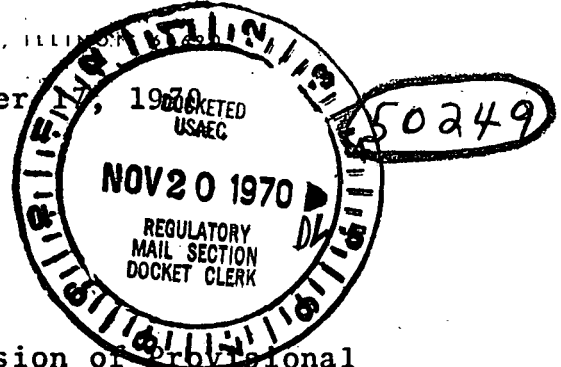

Subject: Application for Extension of Provisional Construction Permit CPPR-22

Dear Dr. Morris:

Provisional Construction Permit CPPR-22, which was issued to Commonwealth Edison Company for the construction of Dresden Nuclear Power Station Unit 3 under AEC Docket 50-249, included a latest completion date of December 1, 1970. At the time of the extension which was issued on May 28, 1970, it was felt that an operating license would be obtained for Unit 3 by this date.

Construction of Dresden Unit 3 is essentially complete and, at this time, we are awaiting the issuance of the Intent to License before loading fuel.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.55, Commonwealth Edison hereby requests that the latest completion date for its Dresden Nuclear Power Station Unit 3, specified in Provisional Construction Permit CPPR-22, be extended to February 1, 1971.

This date should provide ample time for the completion of construction and the issuance of an operating license, and we do not anticipate any need to further extend this date.

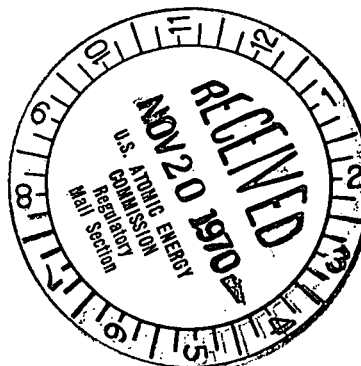
