Additional Information Request

- 1. Is the previously performed overpressure analysis for Dresden Unit 3 (your letter dated May 21, 1974) applicable to the Reload 3 operation?

 Demonstrate that the difference in results of the overpressure analysis performed with the assumption that all safety valves operate versus one safety valve failure does not change for this reload application. Are the inputs to this analysis (e.g., 100% power instead of 93% power and the use of a different dynamic void coefficient) appropriate to this reload? If the sensitivity analysis does not apply, then we require an overpressure analysis with one failed safety valve based on the same input data that were applied to the overpressure analyses for the Reload 3 application.
- 2. Our letter of April 9, 1975, included a request for information regarding the Appendix K reanalysis. Include in your response to our April 9 letter, information of the type presented in your letters of April 21, 1975, for Quad Cities 2, Docket No. 50-265.
