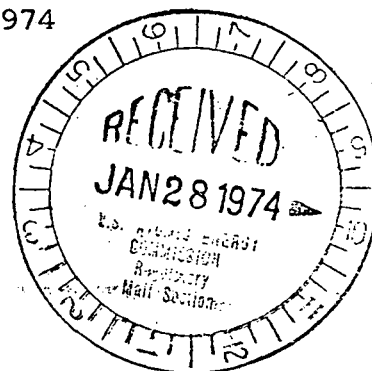
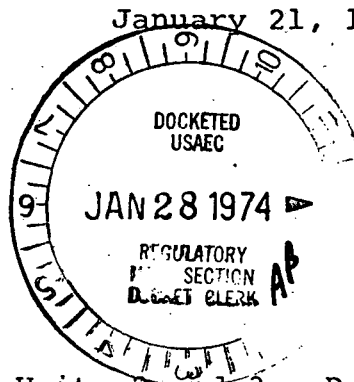

Subject: Dresden Station Units 2 and 3 - Proposed
 Change to DPR-19 and DPR-25 - AEC Dkts
 50-237 and 50-249

Dear Mr. O'Leary:

By letter to you dated October 9, 1973, a proposed change to Appendix A of DPR-19 and DPR-25 was submitted. The purpose of this change was to modify the Technical Specification concerning automatic generation control of Dresden Units 2 and 3 from the System Power Supply Office. The proposed lower limit of permissible flow control was in error and should be 65% of rated core flow rather than 50% as indicated in the October 9, 1973 request.

Pursuant to Section 50.59 of 10 CFR 50 and Paragraph 3.B of Facility Licenses DPR-19 and DPR-25, Commonwealth Edison submits a proposed change to Appendix A of DPR-19 and DPR-25. The purpose of this change is to correct the proposed change submitted October 9, 1973 as discussed above. The proposed change is indicated on the attached Pages 60 and 65 of Appendix A of DPR-19 and DPR-25.

The basis for this change and the safety analyses are reported in the revisions to Amendment 9/10, Question I.E and Pages 7.3-5, 7.3-6 and Figure 7.3.2 of the Final Safety Analysis Report submitted by letter dated October 9, 1973.

This proposed change to the Technical Specifications has received Onsite and Offsite review and approval.


