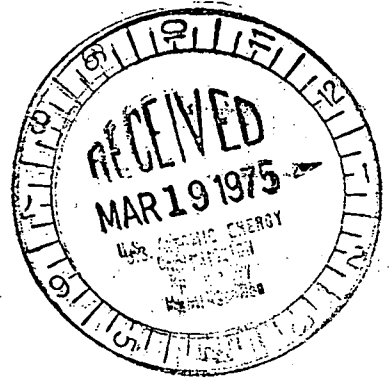

Dear Mr. Ziemann:

Pursuant to Part 50.59 of 10CFR50, Commonwealth Edison Company requests an amendment to DPR-19, DPR-25, DPR-29 and DPR-30, Appendix A, Dresden Station Units 2 and 3 and Quad-Cities Station Units 1 and 2 Technical Specifications. The purpose of the amendment is to modify the Technical Specifications to include limiting conditions for operation, surveillance requirements and bases for the standby gas treatment systems. The amendments are in response to the letter from Mr. Dennis L. Ziemann to Mr. J. S. Abel dated January 7, 1975. The amendments are indicated in Enclosure 1 for Dresden Units 2 and 3 and Enclosure 2 for Quad-Cities Units 1 and 2.

The proposed amendments have received Onsite and Offsite review and have been approved as involving no unreviewed safety considerations.
