

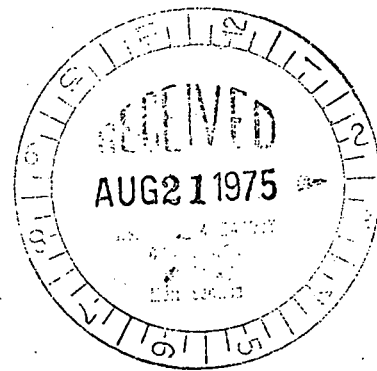
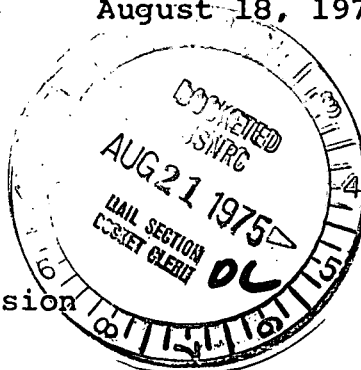

Dear Mr. Goller:

In response to your letters dated June 23, 1975, we have prepared the attached Refueling Information for Dresden Units 2 and 3 and Quad-Cities Units 1 and 2. The information includes our best estimate of the possible licensing amendments which may require NRC staff review. As indicated in the attached information, the anticipated licensing activities can be handled separate from the reload (safety valve and scram reactivity modifications), or involve an aspect of the reload which has previously been reviewed and approved at other similar facilities (2.62 w/o U-235 fuel). On the basis of these factors, the license changes associated with these reloads should be minimal.

Dresden Unit 1 is scheduled to be shutdown for refueling in mid September 1975 and returned to service in mid December 1975. Since the fuel to be loaded is the same design as previously reviewed and approved and no other significant modifications are planned, no unreviewed safety considerations or license amendments have been identified.
