

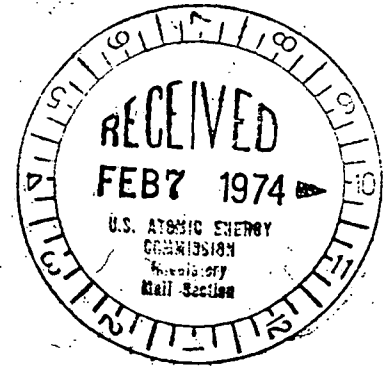

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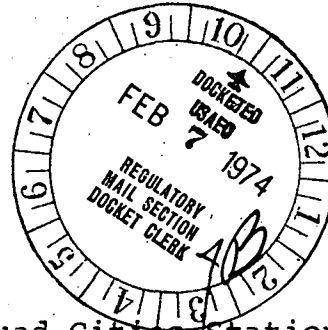

Subject: Dresden and Quad-Cities Stations - Status of
 Pending Reports - AEC Dkts 50-10, 50-237,
50-249 50-254 and 50-265

Dear Mr. Ziemann:

A number of reports to the AEC concerning Dresden and Quad-Cities are pending. The latest review of the status of these reports indicates the following schedules for submittal.

Dresden Units 2 and 3 and Quad-Cities Units 1 and 2 -
 Safety Valve Studies:

As indicated in our letter dated September 25, 1973, and your response dated October 18, 1973, a report of the final corrective measures was scheduled for submittal in January, 1974; however, the development and evaluation of alternate corrective measures has extended the expected submittal date to March, 1974. The major reason for this change in schedule is the complexity of combining the safety valve evaluation with the interrelated corrective measures for revised scram reactivity curves.

Dresden Unit 1 Modified Off-Gas System:

The report describing the modified off-gas treatment system which has been purchased for Dresden Unit 1 was originally scheduled to be submitted in January, 1974. A draft of the report has been reviewed and it is being revised into final form. It is expected the final version of the report will be submitted by mid-February, 1974.


