



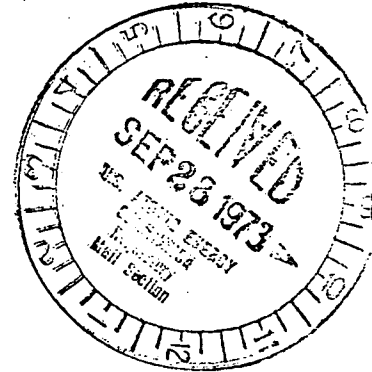
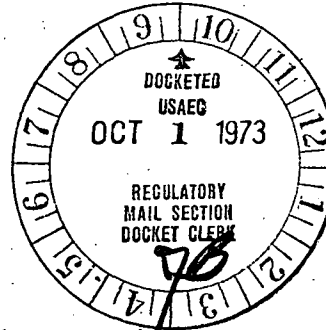

Dear Mr. Ziemann:

We have previously indicated to you our plans for refueling Quad-Cities Unit 1 starting in September, 1973. This refueling was to involve loading approximately sixty new 7 x 7 fuel assemblies. A recent re-examination of our system outage schedule in light of recent fuel performance experience and system requirements has resulted in the following revised schedule:


