

In letters to you dated July 2, 1974 and July 24, 1974, the results of the Dresden Unit 3 and Quad-Cities Unit 1 control rod inspections and evaluations were reported, and approval was requested to discontinue the interim actions required in a letter from Mr. D. J. Skovholt dated April 1, 1974. Upon re-examining the April 1, 1974 letter, it is our understanding that all the requirements for discontinuing the requested interim actions have been met; therefore, operation of these two reactors will be limited by the applicable license and Technical Specifications. The requirement of the letter from Mr. D. J. Skovholt dated April 1, 1974, will be discontinued.
