



Attached is supplement A to Special Report No. 26 "Dresden Unit 3 Start-up Test Report." This supplement contains information concerning vibration measurements performed on Dresden Unit 3 during start-up. This information is considered proprietary by General Electric Company. This information is furnished to Commonwealth Edison Company and the Atomic Energy Commission for the purpose of comparing the results of vibration measurements on Dresden Unit 3 taken during the start-up test program with the design criteria.

This information is unpublished and is considered to be proprietary by General Electric Company. Previous submittals concerning vibration testing have been considered proprietary and approved by the AEC. An example is Amendment No. 19 to the Quad-Cities Final Safety Analysis Report, AEC DKT's 50-254 and 50-265.

It is requested that the AEC withhold Supplement A to Dresden Special Report No. 26 from public disclosure in accordance with 10CFR 2.790(b). It is believed that public disclosure of this information is not required and that public disclosure would adversely affect the interests of General Electric Company.
