SUBJECT: REQUESTS FOR CONSENT TO NRC LICENSE TRANSFERS

By letter dated May 15, 2017, Zevacor Pharma, Inc. dba Zevacor submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) a request for consent to an indirect license transfer of NRC Materials License No. 45-25221-05. Based on the information provided, the NRC understands that 100 percent of the equity shares of GRD PET Operations, Inc. (the parent company of Zevacor Pharma, Inc.), will be sold to Sofie Network, Inc. Following the sale, GRD PET Operations, Inc. will be a wholly owned subsidiary of Sofie Network, Inc., and Zevacor Pharma, Inc. will remain a wholly owned subsidiary of GRD PET Operations, Inc. We further understand that this transfer will not result in any changes to the licensee name, licensed materials, persons using the licensed material, location of use, or persons responsible for the radiation safety program.

In addition, by letter dated May 19, 2017, Global Isotopes, LLC dba Zevacor Molecular submitted to the NRC a request for consent to a direct license transfer of NRC Materials License No. 24-32827-01MD. Based on the information provided, the NRC understands the direct transfer will result from an asset purchase agreement between Sofie Network, Inc. and Global Isotopes, LLC. Following the sale, Sofie Network will be the new owner of Global Isotopes, LLC dba Zevacor Molecular. We further understand that this transfer will not result in any changes to the licensee name, licensed materials, persons using the licensed material, location of use, or persons responsible for the radiation safety program.

Based on the above understandings and as more fully detailed in the enclosed NRC staff's Safety Evaluation Reports (one for each affected license), which document the NRC staff's review of the requests, we consent to the proposed transfers. Please note that you will need to notify us promptly, in writing, after the transaction has been finalized and include a signed copy of the sales agreement(s) confirming completion of the transaction. If this transaction has not been consummated within 30 days of the date of this letter please notify us in writing or the NRC's consent may be considered null and void. Future changes to either license such as the licensee's name, licensed use, licensed materials, licensed location, or persons responsible for licensed material require submission of a request to amend the license(s). NRC approval must be received prior to implementation of the proposed change(s).

Also, with regard to NRC License No. 45-25221-05, Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 30.35(f) requires that for any information changes, such as a licensee name change, financial assurance instruments reflecting such changes must be submitted within 30 days. Please be advised that you may be required to submit revised financial assurance documents following the completion of the transaction.

The NRC's Safety Culture Policy Statement became effective in June 2011.
