Westinghouse Electric Company LLC ("Westinghouse") has received the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's ("NRC") Office of International Programs ("OIP") letter EA-17-075, titled "WESTINGHOUSE ELECTRIC COMPANY – EXPORT OF NUCLEAR REACTOR EQUIPMENT AND EXERCISE OF EXPORT ENFORCEMENT," sent on August 21, 2017 (ADAMS Accession No. ML17215A945).

Westinghouse has reviewed the information in the NRC's letter, and confirms that it understands NRC's interpretation that certain exports ("Items"), as described in Westinghouse's letter to the NRC on May 3, 2017, meet the description of nuclear facilities, equipment, and non-nuclear materials listed in Annex II of the Protocol Additional to the Agreement Between the United States of America and the International Atomic Energy Agency for the Application of Safeguards in the United States, and are thus reportable under Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 110.54(a)(1). Westinghouse looks forward to additional guidance from OIP on this issue, including an explanation of the basis for this determination.

Consistent with this NRC determination, Westinghouse intends to continue to report exports of these Items in its quarterly reports to the U.S. Department of Commerce.

There are no new commitments in this letter.
