List of Approved Spent Fuel Storage Casks: Holtec International HI-STORM 100 Cask System; Certificate of Compliance No. 1014, Amendment No. 9, Revision 1, and Amendment No. 10 Corrections; 3150-AJ63 and 3150-AJ71, NRC-2015-0156 and NRC-2015-0270

On August 31, 2017 ([82 FR 41321](#)), the NRC published a notice in the *Federal Register* correcting two direct final rules published on January 6, 2016, and March 14, 2016. The January 6 direct final rule amended the NRC's spent fuel storage regulations by revising the Holtec International, Inc., HI-STORM 100 Cask System listing within the "List of approved spent fuel storage casks," to include Amendment No. 9, Revision 1, to Certificate of Compliance (CoC) No. 1014. The March 14 direct final rule included Amendment No. 10 to CoC No. 1014. The technical specifications for both amendments contained minor editorial and non-substantive errors. This notice corrected those errors.

On September 5, 2017 ([82 FR 41873](#)), the NRC published a notice in the *Federal Register* confirming the effective date of September 11, 2017, for the direct final rule that was published in the *Federal Register* on June 28, 2017. That direct final rule amended NRC's spent fuel storage regulations by revising the "List of approved spent fuel storage casks" to include Amendment No. 3 to Certificate of Compliance No. 1032 for the Holtec Flood/Wind Multipurpose Canister Storage System.
