

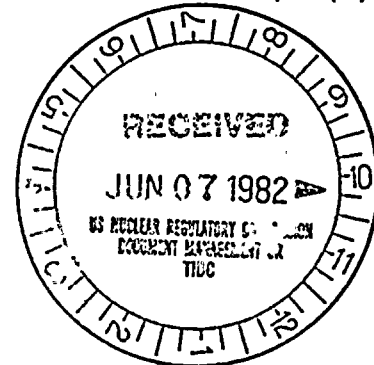

Gentlemen:

On May 22, 1982, the USNRC's Division of Licensing (DL) issued Amendment No. 51 to Operating License No. DPR-18 for the R. E. Ginna Nuclear Power Plant. This amendment and its accompanying Safety Evaluation Report (NUREG-0916) approved restart of the facility and Technical Specification changes regarding the reactor coolant system iodine activity requested in your application dated May 17, 1982, as supported by your submittals dated April 12 and 26, 1982, relating to restart.

Based on their final review of the May 17 application and supporting documents, as well as your application notarized on April 16, 1982, relating to containment isolation, the DL staff have informed us that they consider all of these items as being pertinent to the Ginna restart and that the review involved consideration of a complex issue which requires a Class IV fee of \$12,300. Since your applications of April 16 and May 17 remitted a total of \$8,000 (two Class III fees) pursuant to 10 CFR 170.22, there remains due a sum of \$4,300. It is requested that the \$4,300 be remitted to this office to complete the required fees. We note that Amendment No. 50 was issued on May 22, 1982, for your April 16 application.
