Dear Ms. Hill:

This letter is being sent to notify you that on or about **September 16, 2017**, Siouxland Surgery Center Limited Liability Partnership, d/b/a Dunes Surgical Hospital (License # 10580) (the "Transferee"), a specialized, physician-owned hospital located at 600 Sioux Point Road, Dakota Dunes, South Dakota 57049, is planning to acquire the above-referenced ambulatory surgery center, Siouxland Urology Center, LLC, located at 455 Sioux Point Road, Dakota Dunes, South Dakota 57049 (the "Transferor"), to convert the Transferor into an on-campus, provider-based outpatient surgery department of the Transferee. As part of this transaction the Transferee will be acquiring all or substantially all of the assets used in connection with the Transferor's Radioactive Materials License (License # 50-34223-01) issued by your office. In order to assess whether this is a transfer of control, I am providing you with the following information:

- 1. All or substantially all of the Transferor's assets, including those related to its Radioactive Materials License, will be acquired by Siouxland Surgery Center, LLP d/b/a Dunes Surgical Hospital. The Transferee's mailing address is 600 Sioux Point Road, Dakota Dunes, South Dakota 57049, and the appropriate contact person is Greg Miner, CEO, who may be reached at (605) 232-3332 or gminer@uspi.com.
- 2. Following the transaction, the Transferor will be operated as an outpatient provider-based surgery department of the Transferee. However, it will continue to be operated by the same clinical personnel and at the same high standards that it always has. Training programs will be consistent with those administered by the Transferee and NRC regulations.
- 3. There will be no change in the locations, facilities, equipment, radiation safety program, use, possession, waste management, or other procedures relating to the Radioactive Materials License as a result of this transaction.

- 4. There are no known contaminations of the facility nor are any decontamination efforts underway. All calibrations, leak tests, area surveys, wipe tests, training, quality control, and related records are current and in compliance with NRC standards.
- 5. This item is not applicable based on the types and quantities of radioactive materials authorized by the license.
- 6. All records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility will be transferred to the Transferee as part of the transaction. This includes documentation of surveys of ambient radiation levels and fixed and/or removable contamination, including methods and sensitivity.
- 7. Both Transferor and Transferee agree to transferring control of the licensed material and activity and the conditions of said transfer. The Transferee has been made aware of any open inspection items and its responsibility for possible resulting enforcement actions.
- 8. Transferee will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of the Transferor.
- 9. Not applicable. The license is not for a fuel cycle facility.



### Good morning Jackie,

It was nice speaking with you yesterday. Thank you so much for your quick response and guidance. I am writing this morning to follow up on our conversation. First, I would like to formally request that you expedite our license transfer request for the following reasons: (1) Siouxland Urology Center, LLC will be acquired by Dunes Surgical Hospital on 9/15 (with an effective date of 9/16) and from that point forward it will be operated as an outpatient provider-based department of the hospital; and (2) the facility is scheduled to provide a patient with procedure on 9/29, which will require radioactive materials. I have been informed that the radioactive materials for this procedure will need to be ordered about 10 days in advance (which would be after the change of ownership occurs), and we want to ensure that the Hospital is able to order these essential materials following the acquisition. Our primary concern is that we are able to avoid any disruption in patient services, with a secondary consideration that we would like to avoid any delays in closing the transaction effective 9/16.

During our conversation yesterday you indicated that if I provided you with a request in writing, you might be able to somewhat expedite the license transfer process. You also indicated that even if the transfer of license process was not entirely completed, that this should not interrupt either our ability to offer needed medical services to our patients or our ability to close out the transaction by virtue of the fact that we have provided you with the transfer request in advance of the transaction signed by both the transferor and transferee. If you could provide me with written confirmation of these points so that I can pass them along to the interested parties, it would be greatly appreciated. Thank you again for all of your assistance with this matter.
