Enclosed is an application, dated August 24, 2017, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), from AREVA Inc. for amendment No. 03 to its existing license, XSNM3747/02. The license presently authorizes the export of low-enriched uranium to Japan for use as reload fuel in the Tomari Nuclear Power Stations, Units 1 and 3.

The purpose of the amendment is to change the licensee's name from AREVA, Inc. to AREVA Inc.

We intend to issue the requested license after the 30-day time period allotted for public review expires and it is determined applicable export license criteria are met.
