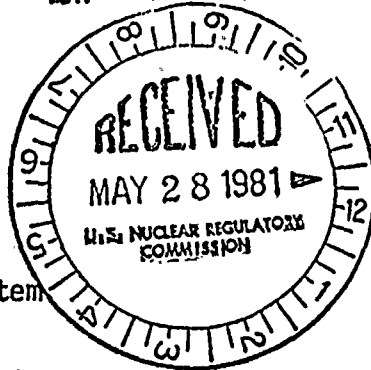

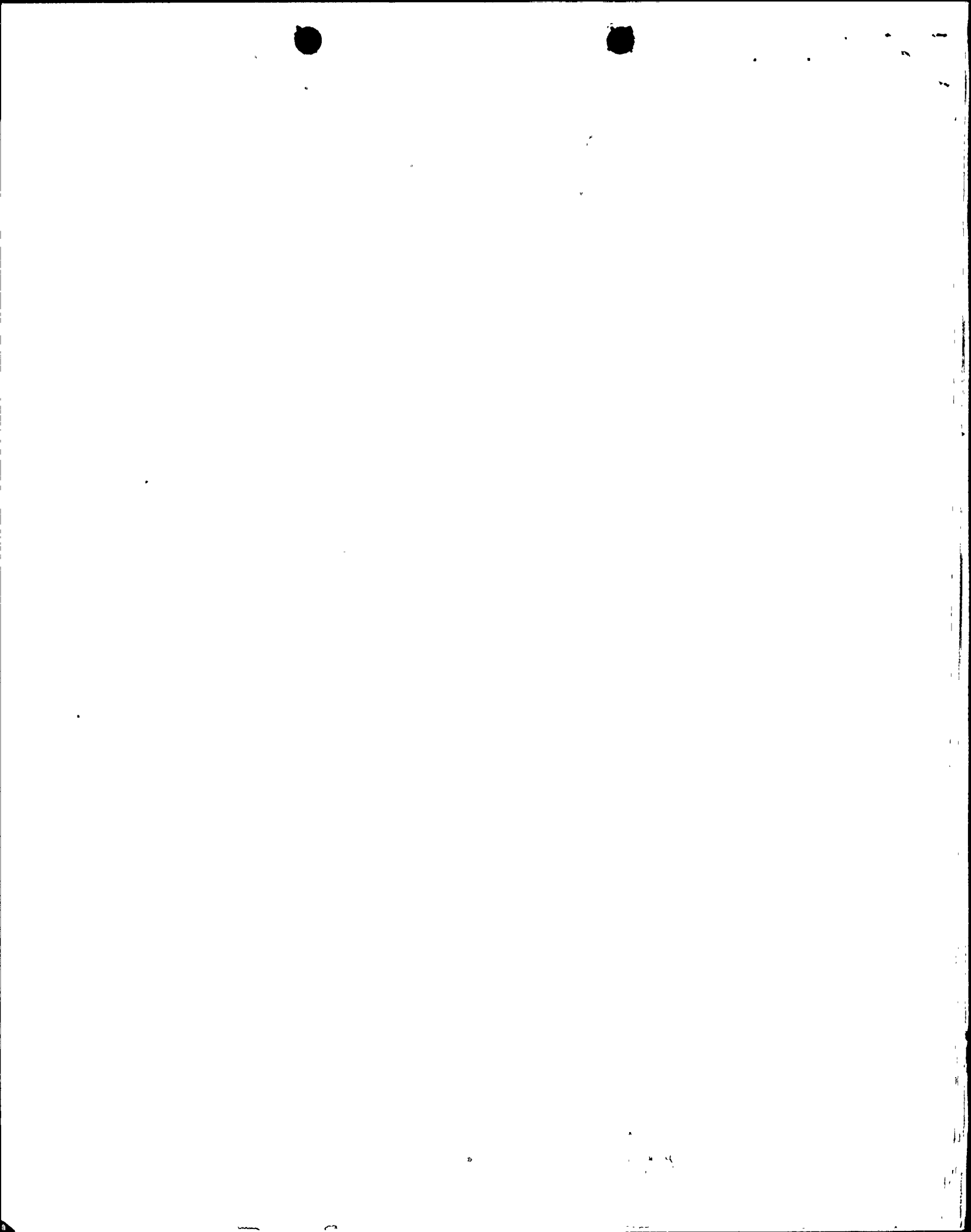

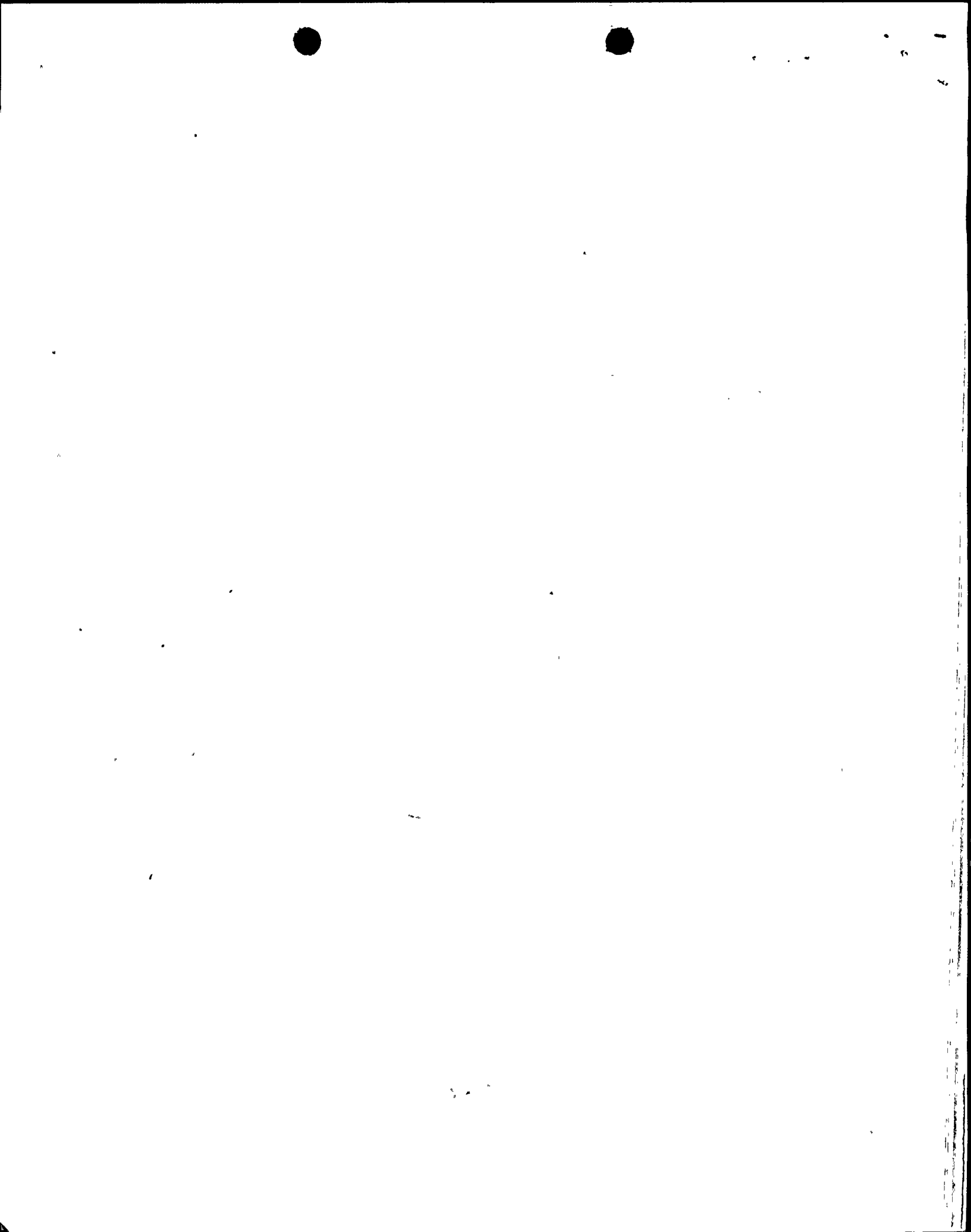

COMMENTS ON WNP-2 GUARD TRAINING PLAN

Specific Comments

- 500.60 5.0 & 9.0 Delete the term "annually" and commit to requalifying at least every 12 months.
- 500.61 6.0 & 7.3.6 Commit to retaining all documentation and test results on site for at least a 2-year period.
- 500.62 7.2 Provide details on the schedule to qualify personnel as required by 10 CFR 73.55(b)(4).

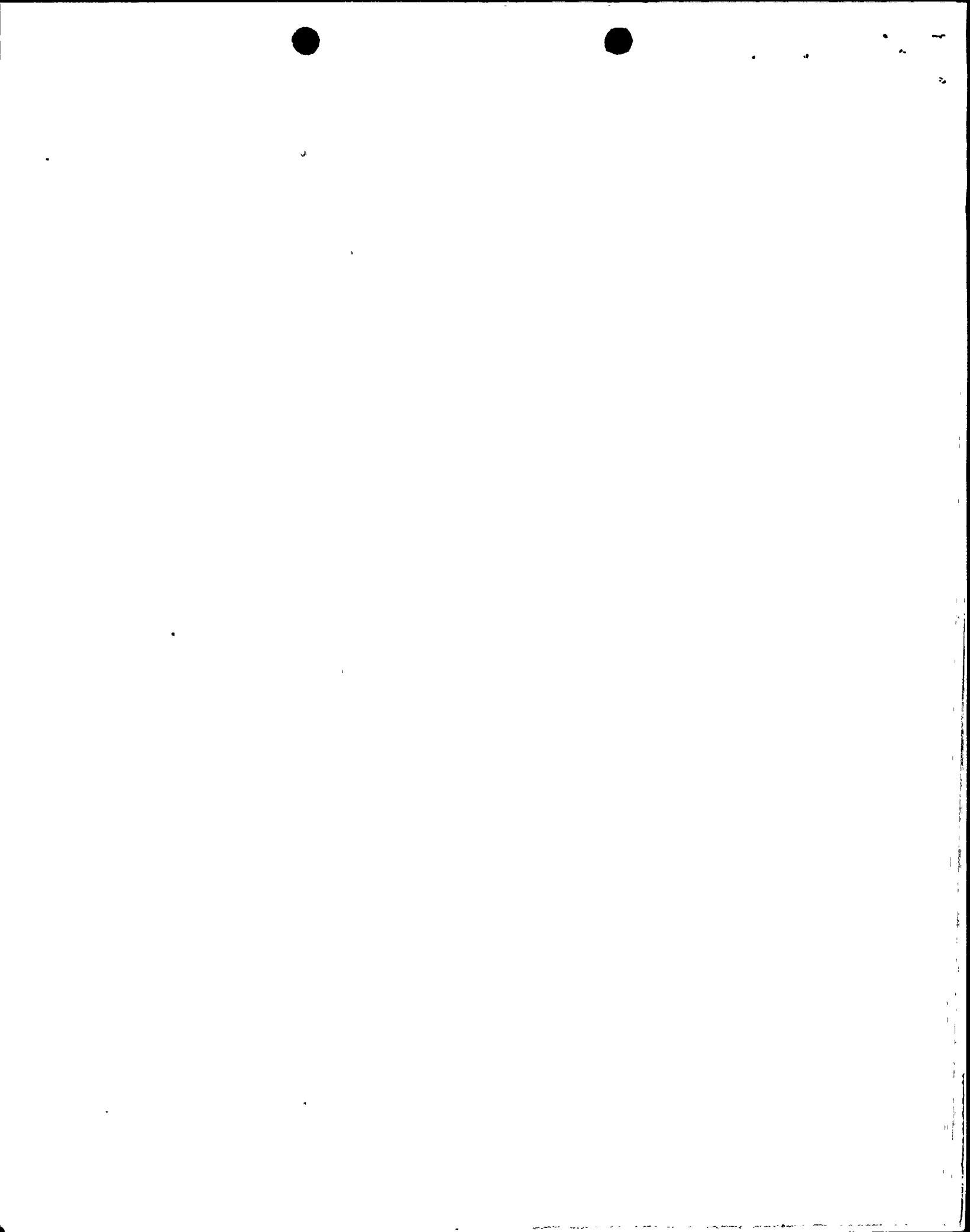
- 500.63 Commit to retaining results of physical fitness qualification results on site for at least a 2-year period.
- 500.64 Correct the reference to Appendix B.I.C.2 by deleting the "2". In addition, specifically commit to a medical examination within the 30 days preceding the physical fitness test.

Appendix 3

- 500.65 6.7.7 Commit to having the CAS/SAS operators test the security system equipment for operability.

Appendix 4

- 500.66 6.7.1 & 6.7.4 Commit to training the guard to take specific actions upon finding any unauthorized materials, especially a weapon, during the metal detection search.
- 500.67 6.7.5 Commit to training the guard to take specific actions upon finding any unauthorized materials during the X-ray search.
- 500.68 6.7.6 Commit to training the guard to take specific actions upon finding explosives during the explosives search.
- 500.69 7.1.5 Commit to training the escort guard to maintain control over visitors, permit access only to authorized areas, detect unauthorized activities and notify the CAS/SAS when a security violation occurs.
- 500.70 7.1.5 Commit to training the guard to brief visitors regarding emergency procedures, areas of authorized access and unauthorized activities.



- 500.71 7.3.1 Commit to training the guard to search the cabs, the engine
7.3.2 compartment, the undercarriage, and the cargo area for
7.3.3 unauthorized persons and materials.
- 500.72 7.3.5 Commit to training the escort guard to maintain continual
control over both driver and vehicle; to lock and secure
the vehicle if left unattended; and to insure that unauthorized
materials are not loaded and/or unloaded.
- 500.73 7.4 Commit to training the guards to search packages delivered
7.4.1 into the protected area in accordance with 10 CFR 73.55(d)(3)
7.4.2 requirements.
- 500.74 7.5.2 Commit to training the guards to specifically permit access
to only authorized individuals and offsite emergency response
personnel.
- 500.75 10.1.6 Provide information as to stage times, number of rounds and
target size to be used.
- 500.76 10.31 Commit to firing the shotgun at the 15 yard distance from
.0 the hip position and the 25 yard distance from the shoulder
position.

Additional Information

- 500.77 Commit to training guards to perform hands on searches of
personnel in accordance with 10 CFR 73.55(d)(3) and (4).
