Subject: SYSTEMATIC ASSESSMENT OF LICENSEE PERFORMANCE (SALP)

The NRC Region V SALP Review Board met on September 20, 1982, and evaluated the performance of the licensed activities at the Washington Nuclear Project No. 2. The draft report of our assessment is enclosed.

Several functional areas were considered areas of weakness requiring additional NRC and Washington Public Power Supply System attention, particularly with regard to increasing management involvement and control of the identified activities, as discussed in Section IV of the enclosed report.
