SUBJECT:	STAFF REQUIREMENTS – SECY-17-0081 – STATUS AND RESOLUTION OF ISSUES ASSOCIATED WITH THE TRANSFER OF SIX DECOMMISSIONING URANIUM MILL SITES TO THE STATE OF WYOMING

The Commission has approved the staff's recommended Option 2, under which the NRC would retain regulatory authority over the American Nuclear Corporation (ANC) site, in Gas Hills, Wyoming, after the State of Wyoming, under an anticipated limited Section 274b. Agreement, would assume regulatory authority over five other Wyoming sites in the same materials category. This approval is not a change to the Commission's current Agreement State policy, but is instead an exception to that policy based on case-specific facts.

The staff should move expeditiously to conclude negotiation of the agreement and present it to the Commission for review and ratification.
