
Reference: Letter, G.D. Bouchey (Supply System) to D.G. Eisenhut,

The reference letter requested NRC approval of a one year retention period for radiation exposure records used in preparing Form NRC-4 for employees whose original exposure records would be maintained by previous employers. Recent followup of this item disclosed that we have no record of response as of this date.
